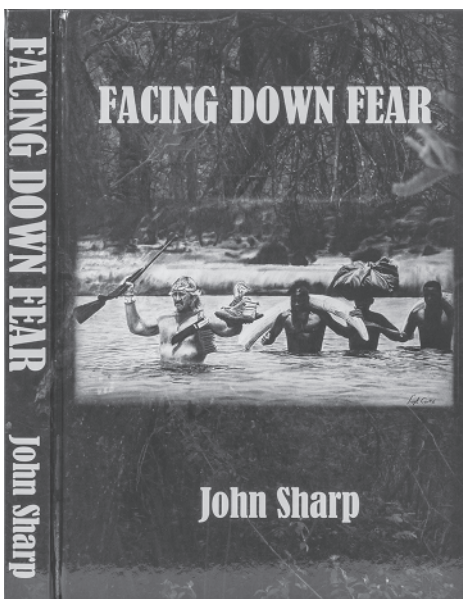

He appreciates the work that both the professional hunter and his clients must put forth and describes trophy bull elephant hunting as something that fits in with a basic understanding of nature.
