17. Burger, J. AFRICAN CAMP FIRE NIGHTS 1959 London 192 pp. Ill. Stories told by hunters, professional and otherwise, around evening campfires. Includes some spellbinding tales told by "those who survived." One of the scarcest of all Burger titles. It's been 7 years since we had a copy in jacket! Fine copy in near fine dj. \$ 500.00
18. Burnham, F. R. TAKING CHANCES 1944 CA 293 pp. Ill. By the author of Scouting on Two Continents. His second, originally privately printed autobiography. Contains some elephant hunting and thoughtful piece, "Taps for the Great Selous." Hinges are weak but the covers are nice and the book is fine internally. Four places in the text where a reader has handwritten corrections to misspelled names. Scarce in first edition. \$ 225.00
19. Burton, E.F. REMINISCENCES OF SPORT IN INDIA 1885 London 419 pp, ill. The author spent a long time in the Indian Service and spent virtually all of his spare time hunting throughout the country. Obviously a lot of great tiger hunting stories, as well as leopard, bear, etc. A classic of India big game hunting. Alas, a fair condition only copy, loose in binding, rear cover soiled at bottom, spine wrinkled. Front cover, however, with gilt illustration is nice. Declé travelled from Cape Town to the Zambesi, then north through Tanzania and into Uganda. A good picture of the rigors of camp life and sport (he was not a lucky hunter). Livingstone's encounters with elephants had been dramatically recounted by Thomas Baines and Faulkner anticipated the hunting thrills when he set out on his own expedition.
